Wheaton, owner of *Salon 53*, a private residential art gallery, invited seven other Black galleries to be Founding Members: 10th Street Gallery, 14th Street Artist Community Gallery, Bentil's Jah'z Art Private Gallery, Exodus Gallery, Gya Community Art Gallery, L.D. Ingrum Gallery & Studio, and Portfolio Gallery & Education Center. Salon 53 is the Think Tank for the Hands Up, Don't Shoot: Artists Respond Arts Initiative, the second thematic exhibition of the Alliance. The first was a commemoration of the 250th anniversary of the founding of St. Louis. The Alliance received the *St. Louis Magazine* **2014 A-List Award** for arts collaboration.
